The University of Arizona Hispanic Alumni Scholarship Application

The University of Arizona Hispanic Alumni (UAHA) was formed in 1982 to promote academic excellence among Hispanic students at the University of Arizona. The UAHA is an official constituent group of the University of Arizona Alumni Association. UAHA focuses on assisting in recruitment and graduation of academically talented and financially needy students.

PURPOSE

Through the UAHA Scholarship Endowment Program, our organization provides mentoring, networking and financial assistance to students committed to serving the Hispanic community, including students of Hispanic origin. Financial assistance may consist of an award designated towards tuition, a cash award, or a book scholarship

CONDITIONS

The UA Hispanic Alumni Club welcomes your application for financial assistance. Please read and complete the scholarship application carefully, taking into consideration that this application is our only means of evaluating your qualifications.

In order to be considered for a UAHA scholarship, your application must be postmarked or received or no later than **Friday, December 14**.

1. Before submitting the UAHA scholarship application, incoming freshmen must submit to the UA Office of Admissions an online or hard copy (paper) University of Arizona admissions application and all other materials necessary for enrollment at the University. Please go to the provided Web site, or see your high school counselor to apply. <http://admissions.arizona.edu/requirements.html>
2. To be considered for UAHA financial assistance, all applicants must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). You must file on or after **January 1**, and by **February 14**, to ensure optimal financial assistance. Please log on to the following Web site to download a FAFSA or to submit a FAFSA online: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>
3. UAHA scholarships are not automatically renewed each year. Recipients are required to complete 24 units per academic year and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.8 (2.5 for freshmen).
4. Students must fill out a UAHA Renewal Form by February 14 for continued UAHA assistance.
5. Freshmen scholarship recipients are required to take, LRC 297b-001, Freshman Success Express class. All other UAHA scholarship recipients must participate and assist with UAHA events and attend scheduled monthly student meetings.

4. Signed and dated UAHA scholarship application.
5. I will submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by either filing the Online application or submitting a hard-copy (paper version) by February 14.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Completed applications must be postmarked or received no later than December 14.
2. All applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
3. All applicants must be Arizona residents.
4. All applicants must demonstrate knowledge and understanding of Hispanic heritage and commitment to serving the Hispanic community.
5. Each recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 12 units per semester) at the University of Arizona for the academic year for which financial aid is being sought. If the recipient is a graduate student or professional student, the recipient must be admitted to the graduate/professional college as a full-time graduate student or professional student.
6. Application materials will not be returned to applicant after submission.
7. The UA Scholarship Office must be notified of any other financial assistance offered to applicant.

One letter of recommendation is required from a school official who is familiar with your academic and personal achievements, as well as your potential for future success. It is your responsibility to ensure the letter of recommendation is included with your application. Recommendations received separately will not be accepted.
